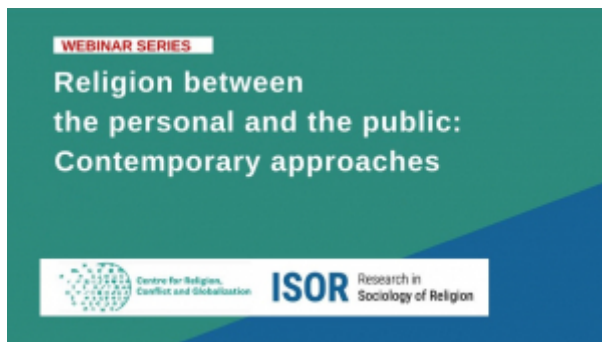

Religion, gender and sexuality: Embodiment as a key theoretical tool

Taking an embodied lens when researching religion offers crucial insights in understanding gender and religion, and complements lived religion approaches (McGuire 2008). In conceptualising how embodiment can be applied to the study of religion, gender and sexuality, Page and Pilcher (2021) outline six elements to embodiment – space, time, power, relationality, projects of the self, and projects of religious/spiritual communities. In this presentation, Page will out-line this perspective and will reflect on this theoretical work in relation to some of the projects she has undertaken, such as child sexual abuse in religious institutions, and religiously-inspired anti-abortion activism.
